- 8. Help us to know our battle is not against people but against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places.

- 9. Pray words would be given to us in boldly proclaiming the mystery of the Gospel.

- 10. Pray that we would put on the full armor of God Ephesians 6:13-17
 - a. We would stand on God's truth.
 - b. We would realize our righteousness is not our own but is from God through Jesus Christ.
 - c. We would live each day in the gospel and always be ready to share it with anyone and everyone.
 - d. Increase and strengthen our faith to trust God in all circumstances.
 - e. Pray our minds and hearts would be guarded by the salvation provided to us by Jesus Christ
 - f. Give us a passion and zeal to know and share the Word of God
 - g. Give us a gospel awareness to always be ready for people and circumstances in our lives where we can make Jesus known.

- 3. Pray a culture of serving in the church and in the community would continue through the different generations present in our church.
- **4.** Pray transparent and meaningful relationships would become normal and remaining anonymous would become strange.
- Pray the preaching of God's Word would be Biblically careful and Holy Spirit saturated.
